

## Textbook Ordering Instructions for Physics/Honors Physics

Both the Physics and Honors Physics courses will use electronic textbooks published by Kinetic Books. To enable the students to access the text at home or school, you should purchase the one-year web-access license. This license will allow your daughter to install and use the book on any (and multiple) computer(s) with an internet connection. All of the computers in the US computer lab, Crile library, and the science laptops have the program installed. You will need internet access to purchase, install, and use the book.

When you purchase the book, you will receive an email containing a link to download the software. The book may be installed on either Mac or PC and the choice can be made when you download the software. PLEASE KEEP THIS EMAIL FOR THE ENTIRE SCHOOL YEAR. If you do lose the email, you can request assistance directly from Kinetic Books through their [support page](#).

The web-access license also comes with a PDF of the entire book, allowing students to print out sections to read or mark up. Some students have found this feature useful, taking small sections of printed text to study while on the road.

### Installation Instructions

The instructions for downloading and installing the software, along with the required log-in email address and password, are contained in the email sent by Kinetic Books. If you have not received the email in your inbox, be sure to check your junk-mail folder as some spam filters may misidentify it.

To Students:

Read Chapter 0 before the first day of class; it introduces you to the features of the book. To open the book, you need to double-click on the book icon and log in. Try some of the Interactive sections and click on some of the Concept boxes. If you have your computer volume turned on, you will find that these (and all parts of the book) are spoken. There are icons on the bottom of the screen that can be used to highlight material in the book and to take notes that can be saved with the book. Also be sure to find the Fact Book and try out the Search function. Some links in the book will launch a web browser and lead you to additional information on the Kinetic Books web site. We will not be using the online homework feature.
